

CHAPTER FROM SIDNEY TO AUCKLAND

1 MYSTICAL LANDS AND WONDERS



For the first time in history we start our World Cruise with an overnight in Sydney. After enjoying Australia's culture capital after dark, set sail for Hobart; the cosmopolitan city in Australia's most southerly state. New Zealand is next, and a spectrum of experiences from the ethereal beauty of Milford Sound to the mighty scenery of Picton.



HOBART (TASMANIA) / 12-13 January

Explore booming Hobart during an overnight. An expenal colony, nowadays Australia's second-oldest city is encircled by dramatic cliffs, landscaped gardens, undulating mountains and endless ocean views. Generous sunshine and cool Antarctic breezes help Hobart to produce its acclaimed wines, so be sure to taste a glass of local Pinot Noir.



MILFORD SOUND (NEW ZEALAND) / 16 January

Milford Sound sits within South Island's Fiordland National Park. As one of the four national parks forming the UNESCO World Heritage site "Te Wahipounamu" – pounamu being the local greenstone used for carvings by the Maori - expect steep cliffs, impressive waterfalls and dense rainforest that characterise this 8th wonder of the world.



AKAROA (NEW ZEALAND) / 18 January

There are many stunning places in New Zealand, but none of them can quite hold a candle to Akaroa. At less than 50 km from Christchurch, the town (Maori for "Long Harbour") stands on a peninsula formed by two volcanic cones. Self-styled as nature's playground, such a moniker might seem superlative elsewhere, but, surrounded by natural wonders, Akaroa's epithet is well earnt.


MYSTERY ISLAND, ANELGHOWHAT (VANUATU) / 28 January

This is Papua at its most authentic, linguistically diverse, astonishing cultural variety and a great expression of identity. Divers will also be richly rewarded – the marine life is extraordinary.



ROMBLON (PHILIPPINES) / 12 February

Mesmerising, paradisiacal sands and sparkling waters sum up Romblon. These islands create a truly stirring vision of Asian beauty - dazzling all visitors who head for these turquoise fringed shores. Formerly known as Saigon, the city was affectionately-labelled Pearl of the Orient by the French. 




YANGON (MYANMAR) / 8 - 10 March

Built on a one of the world's largest natural harbours, Trincomalee is a gateway to the deep historical interests of Sri Lanka. Richly cultural and historic, the town is surrounded by treasured sites, many of which are UNESCO World Heritage. Explore the evocative and majestic holy sites in this multicultural, fascinating destination.



PRASLIN (SEYCHELLES) / 20 March

Loved by those who like their paradise au naturel, Praslin is one of the Seychelles' most beautiful islands. The difficulty in getting to it means there are no modern attractions. Entertainment here comes very much from the lush jungle, home to the famous and legendary Coco de Mer, as well as the surrounding sea.

5 AFRICAN ENCOUTERS



A healthy measure of relaxation and exploration comes next. Zanzibar's UNESCO Stone Town promises something extraordinary while authentic experiences take on a new meaning with the lemurs and baobabs of Madagascar. Follow this with some chic à la française in the Reunion and Mauritius, a dose of vitamin sea before the African mainland hoves into view.



ZANZIBAR (TANZANIA) / 25 - 26 March

There is much more to Zanzibar than meets the eye. Breathe in the heady scents and you'll understand why locals call it the Spice Isle. Zanzibar was once on the trading route from Arabia to Africa, the epicentre of which was in the Market Square in the heart of Stone Town. Today Stone Town is a popular UNESCO World Heritage Site.



TOAMASINA (MADAGASCAR) / 31 March

Situated on the east coast of Madagascar, Toamasina is defined by long beaches, endemic flora and fauna, as well as plantations of coffee, vanilla, clove, banana, coconut and lychee. The city itself is jumble of bric-a-brac chic – streets lined with palm trees sit alongside old, crumbling colonial buildings and traditional creole houses.




POINTE DES GALETS (REUNION) / 03 April




CAPE TOWN (SOUTH AFRICA) / 12 - 14 April




TAKORADI (GHANA) / 25 April




13 APRIL 2023 - CAPE TOWN (SOUTH AFRICA)








GUSTAVIA, ST BARTS (FRENCH WEST INDIES) / 24 May






