

OUR FLEXIBILITY PROMISE

We've made it easy to change your travel plans up to 30 days prior to your trip's departure date. You can choose new dates &/or a new destination without penalty on the land portion of your trip.

PRE-TRIP HEALTH DECLARATION

All travellers will complete a personal wellness declaration before joining a trip. If you've tested positive for COVID-19 or are travelling with someone who has, you will not be able to join the trip until cleared as 'fit for travel' by a medical professional.

AIR TRAVEL

Specific details will vary by airline, but standard operations typically include flight attendants wearing masks, sanitising all surfaces between flights & enhanced hygiene protocols. Check with your airline for any change of travel plan fees as these may still apply outside The Travel Corporation Flexibility Promise time frame of 30 days. We recommend travel insurance for any problems that may arise within 30 days of your trip starting.

ALL THE LATEST INFO

We'll be in touch before your trip kicks off with a detailed email, sharing health & hygiene guidelines in accordance with the local guidelines specific to your trip, as well as information around how to recognise COVID-19 symptoms. We want you to feel as prepared as possible by the time your trip departs.

ON TRIP

While you travel with us, you can be sure that we are taking every step to ensure the well-being of all our team & travellers on trip.

ARRIVAL & WELCOME

At a kick off meeting, your Trip
Manager will cover what you can
expect & all the necessary well-being
precautions on trip. These meeting
times have been arranged so you
won't encounter other groups
unnecessarily.

YOUR TRIP

Trip Managers will submit a Self-Health Declaration prior & post trip. Our industry leading training has been adapted & enhanced to include a dedicated module on dealing with COVID-19. They, & our Traveller Support team, are available 24/7 throughout the trip should any situation arise.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING & GROUP SIZE

We control our group sizes in each region to ensure we comply with every destination's distancing requirements & for the peace of mind of all of our travellers.

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

It is important that you bring your own face mask to comply with regional guidelines. It is also a good idea to bring hand sanitiser, with an alcohol concentration above 70%.

VEHICLES

Contiki-arranged vehicles, i.e. mini-vans & 4x4s will be thoroughly sanitised in accordance with local guidelines before your trip.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

We'll let you know the local guidelines to follow in each destination, i.e. whether wearing a mask is required, or boarding & disembarking protocols. We also recommend thoroughly sanitising your hands regularly.







SIGHTSEEING, LOCAL GUIDES, HOTELS & **RESTAURANTS**

Every supplier must be fully compliant with locally mandated standards for us to work with them. We'll arrange priority entrance whenever possible & ensure physical distancing throughout. All our Local Guides will have been trained on hygiene protocols & provided with the same checklists & standards your Trip Manager will adhere to.

SELF-SCREENING

We'll ask all travellers to monitor their health throughout their trip, with protocols in place in the event someone becomes ill or displays symptoms of COVID-19.

AFTER YOUR TRIP



We ask travellers to be in touch should they develop symptoms within 14 days of the trip ending, so that we can alert all travellers & the Trip Manager of your trip.



Incar Trail permits are non-refundable and non-trainsferable so it's essential that you let us know your correct passport details at the time of booking so we can process your application quickly. (Contiki will process your application on your behalf within three days of booking but we cannot guarantee permit availability.) Campsites are subject to change (on the 4 day trek) according to the designation of the governmental institution (Ministerio de Cultura) that regulates the use of the Inca Trail.

WHAT'S MYCONTIKI?

This is our platform to get all the info we need from you & give you all the info you'd like from us.

- We need you to register for your trip at my.contiki.com. This only takes a few minutes & means we'll have:
- Your personal details, including your email address & phone number.
- Your emergency contact info & travel insurance details, just in case we need it.
- Your dietary, medical or other special requirements you may have.
- Your completed Travel Health Declaration before departure.

Provided full payment has been received on time & registration is completed, travel documents will be available to download no later than 21 days prior to travel, as we don't print these (save the trees!). You'll also find out where your Contiki trip will start & exactly what accommodation you'll be staying in — plus the answers to a host of other FAOs.

PASSPORTS, VISAS & OTHER ENTRY & EXIT REQUIREMENTS

WHAT PASSPORT DO I NEED?

All guests must be in possession of a machinereadable passport valid for 6 months after their trip return date along with applicable visas. Due to government imposed security/ immigration measures, passport & emergency contact information is required for all guests prior to the release of travel documents.

WILL I NEED A VISA?

Because the details change so much depending on what country you're from & what country or countries you're travelling to - we can't tell you which Visas, Electronic Travel Authorisations (ETAs), affidavits or immunisations you'll need. In some countries you may be subject to entry (reciprocity) fees &/or departure taxes/exit fees which will becollected at the airports upon entry/departure by local government authorities. We do definitely recommend getting any visas you need before you travel, as it's not always possible or quick to get them at the borders.

For all the latest info on the travel docs, visas, requirements & fees associated with entry & exit of countries, you must check with your Travel Agent or local consular services. It's up to you to ensure you have all the right documents with you when you travel. Contiki bears no responsibility for such information & will not be responsible for advising &/or obtaining required travel documentation for any guest, or for any delays, damages, &/or losses including missed portions of your holiday related to improper documentation or government decisions about entry.

GENERAL INFORMATION & CONDITIONS

MINIMUM NUMBERS

Some trips are based on a minimum number of persons travelling. If a trip fails to satisfy minimum numbers, the trip may be cancelled or rescheduled.

BOOKING WITH A TRAVEL AGENT

AGE RESTRICTIONS

Travellers must be aged between 18 & 35 inclusive at the commencement of your trip to travel with Contiki. Our trips are designed for this age group, so please bear that in mind when you book. On some experiences as part of your trip you may be joined by other travellers who are not in the 18-35 age group. Countries have different age limits for the consumption of alcohol 8 other activities. You must ensure you satisfy the age limits before participating in any activity with age limits (such as the consumption of alcohol) & you release us from all liability & claims arising from your inability to participate in such activities.
