
#### **VISA REQUIREMENTS**

Visas are super important and depending on your nationality you may require a visa to enter the USA and Canada. You are responsible for obtaining all necessary visas prior to the departure of your trip. Contact visas prior to the aeparture of your trip. Cohicy your travel agent (if applicable) to determine if you require a visa and how to get it. You will require a machine readable passport, your passport will need to be valid for at least six months after your arrival. Without enough months are your drival. Without erlough volidity, authorities may deny your entry into a country, even if you're only staying for a short while. It is now mandatory that all nationals, or citizens, of Visa Waiver Program (VWP) countries who plan to travel to the United States for temporary business or pleasure under the VWP receive an electronic travel authorization through ESTA (Electronic System for Travel Authorization) prior to boarding a U.S. bound airplane or vessel. Applications must be filed online at least 72 hours prior to your departure date, at time of printing, the cost is currently US\$14.
